Subject: U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Detroit Field Office Virtual Trade Week 2022

U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Office of Field Operations - Detroit Field Office will host the 11th Annual Trade Week via the virtual platform of Webex on August 2-4, 2022 beginning at 9:30 a.m. EDT on August 2, 2022 and 10:00 a.m. EDT on August 3 and August 4, 2022.

Join CBP subject matter experts as they provide updates on CBP trade priorities and policies. Presenters at this year's event represent a wide range of CBP programs and offices including the Customs Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (CTPAT), Automotive & Aerospace Center, Trade Policy and Programs, Cargo Security & Control and the Agriculture Programs and Trade Liaison Directorate. Additionally, representatives from the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS), Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) will share information regarding their oversight of international trade. Each day will be organized into two 60-minute presentations, with the first day also including an introduction of CBP leadership at the Ports of Entry within the Detroit Field Office and the Automotive and Aerospace Center.

Registration for this free event is limited to 1,000 participants each session due to the virtual platform, so early registration is recommended. Registration will remain open until the participant capacity is reached. Please note each day requires a separate registration.
