About This Project

Halton Region is continuing with the final phase (Contract 3) of improvements to Tremaine Road (Reg. Rd. 22) from Steeles Avenue (Reg. Rd. 8) to Campbellville Road, Ward 1, in the Town of Milton and Ward 2 in the Town of Halton Hills.

Tremaine Road permanent closure across Highway 401

In preparation for the upcoming demolition of the existing Tremaine Bridge over Highway 401, Halton Region would like to inform you that **the existing bridge will be permanently closed across Highway 401 effective July 7, 2025**, weather permitting.

Through traffic will be routed to the new bridge as follows (see attached map for new route):

North of Highway 401

Access to existing Tremaine Road (Reg. Rd. 22) for southbound traffic will be closed at Highway 401. **Detour 4** will route southbound traffic east along Campbellville Road to continue south across Highway 401 on the new bridge.

South of Highway 401

Access to existing Tremaine Road (Reg. Rd. 22) for northbound traffic will be closed at Highway 401. **Detour 3** will route northbound traffic east along 3 Side Road to continue north across Highway 401 on the new bridge.

Demolition of existing Tremaine Road bridge over Highway 401

To support the demolition of the existing Tremaine Road bridge, **all lanes of Highway 401 will be closed from Regional Road 25 to Guelph Line from 9 pm, Saturday, July 12, 2025 to 9 am, Sunday, July 13, 2025**, weather permitting.

If there are unforeseen delays, the **contingency dates** for the bridge demolition and Highway 401 full closure are from 9 pm, Saturday, July 19 to 9 am, Sunday, July 20.

Halton Region has been collaborating with the Ministry of Transportation (MTO) and local municipalities. Both east and westbound traffic will be detoured from Highway 401 to Campbellville Road, just north of the highway. The detour route will be well-marked and traffic control flagging will be in place along the detour route during the closure.

We will make every effort to complete the construction work as quickly as possible to minimize the impact of the Highway 401 closure.
