Leading up to June 12, 2022



Finalize and communicate enforcement approach in Ontario



Initiate set fines and sanctions for ELD-related infractions in Ontario



Initiate training for CVSA trained officers

Intent: Operators are encouraged to research their ELD options and **not wait** until the last moment

Education & awareness

June 12, 2022 – January 1, 2023



Distribute education, awareness products, and reminder notices.



Practical on-road enforcement training for CVSA trained officers



Continued outreach and support for industry to prepare

Intent: To continue to educate and remind operators on ELD requirements and prepare for enforcement

Enforcement

January 1, 2023-Onward



ELD requirements will be enforced in Ontario



Set Fines to range from \$250 to \$400



Sanctions (points) for ELD-related infractions.

Intent: To enforce ELD requirements in Ontario (regardless of where vehicles are plated)

Regulatory amendments completed and communicated to industry

Fall 2021



Updates to enforcement approach have been communicated to industry

Winter 2022



Training for CVSA trained officers complete (refresher training planned for Fall 2022)
